

Over the ages, people have attributed many facts to numbers. Numerology, superstition, important dates, and so many other things cling to various numbers, which in some cases gives them great significance! Today let's take a look at ten interesting facts about the number eight. The number eight can be found naturally all over the world, as it's a Fibonacci number. The sixth number in the Fibonacci sequence, eight, is the only number in this sequence (other than the number one) that is a perfect cube (2³). The following number in the Fibonacci sequence is thirteen, while the previous number is five. A gallon is the equivalent of eight pints within both the US and imperial measurement systems.
