Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are caused by bacteria, viruses, or parasites that can be passed through sexual contact. Most STIs are spread during oral, vaginal, or anal sex without condom use. If you have an STI, avoid sex until treatment is completed to prevent transmission to your partner. SH:24 offers PEP services, with PrEP available at A&E for out-of-hours support. The STI self-sampling kits include a blood sample for syphilis and HIV testing, anal, vaginal, and throat swabs for chlamydia and gonorrhoea, and a urine sample. Kits come with instructions and online video guides. We collaborate with the NHS to continuously develop our sexual health services, making them better and more effective. Information and STI testing are free and available to everyone regardless of age, gender, ethnicity, or sexuality.
