In December 18th, 2019, this historic event took place. Meanwhile, news from the world of sports brought an untimely loss to fans worldwide. The NBA superstars, who wore jersey number 24, tragically met their demise in a helicopter crash in January 2020. This devastating incident shook the hearts of millions, remembering him for his incredible achievements such as winning five NBA championships and earning the title of Most Valuable Player. In April 2023, Finland joined the ranks of NATO's members, becoming the 31st country to do so. This significant move strengthened the alliance, increasing its security perimeter by doubling the length of the bordering member states, which bordered Russia. The United Kingdom finalized its separation from the European Union in January 2020, after a long and arduous process that had begun with David Cameron's promise to hold a referendum on the matter. The death of George Floyd in May 2020 also set off a chain reaction of global protests as an American black man was tragically stopped by police for allegedly using a counterfeit twenty-dollar bill. During this incident, a police officer knelt on his back to subdue him, resulting in his untimely demise. In May 2023, Japan played host to the G7 summit, bringing together world leaders to discuss pressing issues such as the ongoing invasion of Ukraine and the growing influence of China. The summit also featured discussions on how to counterbalance Chinese power. Lastly, the Summer Olympic Games were postponed due to COVID-19, marking a first for the modern Olympics, which had previously been canceled during World Wars I and II. This event was scheduled to take place from July 24th to August 9th, 2020, but its date was pushed back by 12 months. Soldiers from China and India began border skirmishes in the Himalayan region on May 5th, 2020, marking an escalation of tensions between the two nations. The Sino-Indian border disputes have been ongoing issues since the McMahon Line established by the Simla Convention of 1914. The border as legitimate. This dispute led to the Sino-Indian War in 1962 and more recently, skirmishes on May 5, 2020, in Ladakh and the Tibet Autonomous Region near the Sikkim border. In a heartwarming display of determination, Captain Sir Tom Moore inspired many by walking laps of his garden to raise funds for the National Health Service. His modest efforts resulted in 35 million raised, earning him recognition and even an appearance in the New Year fireworks display in London. A devastating explosion occurred in Beirut on August 4, 2020, caused by the storage of ammonium nitrate at the port. The blast resulted in 204 deaths, 6500 injuries, and estimated damages worth \$15 billion. The state of New South Wales in Australia was hit by destructive bushfires from December 2019 to March 2020, burning an estimated 18.6 million hectares and destroying over 5,900 buildings. Reinforcements were sent to help combat the fires, which also had a significant environmental impact. Indian refiners began paying for Russian oil in Chinese yuan in July 2023 due to trade sanctions imposed by Western countries against Russia. India emerged as the largest buyer of seaborne Russian crude oil. Finally, funded by Elon Musk, the Crew Dragon Demo-2 space mission became the first private rocket to dock with the International Space Station. The crew, consisting of former NASA astronauts Douglas Hurley and Robert Behnken, successfully completed their mission on the ISS. The United Arab Emirates normalized an agreement with Israel on September 15, 2020, becoming the third Arab nation to do so after Egypt in 1979 and Jordan in 1994.
