There is some evidence to suggest that this practice has roots in an old Greek and Roman tradition. In that custom, people would hold a feast in memory of the deceased after nine days of mourning. But over time, Roman Catholics started to connect novenas with more overtly Christian symbolism. The first is found in the Acts of the Apostles, where Jesus instructed His following His ascension into heaven. Tradition has it that during the nine days between Jesus' Ascension (which is thought to have occurred 40 days after His Passion/Passover) and Pentecost, the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary went to the Upper Room and prayed for nine days before Christmas to represent the nine months that Jesus was conceived in His mother's womb. How Should the Nine-Day Novena for the Dead Be Prayed? The nine-day Catholic novena is exactly what it sounds like: a prayer for the deceased. It is a series of prayers recited over the course of nine days in memory of a deceased person. Here, we'll outline the procedures for performing this novena: Decide which prayer(s) to use.
