How to get from seville to valencia

Children under 3 years old travel for free with AVE as long as they don't occupy a seat and have their own child ticket. Children between 3 to 14 years old enjoy a 40% discount on ticket prices. On all AVE trains, you can take one bicycle or scooter on board, provided it's folded and stored in a case. The pedals must be removed, and the handlebars turned 90 degrees. Larger bicycles are considered special luggage if they fit within specific dimensions. Pets weighing less than 10 kg can travel with an approved carrier, while guide dogs are free of charge. AVE provides assistance for passengers with disabilities at no cost. Alvia trains allow up to three pieces of luggage and have a café-bar on board. You can connect to PlayRenfe and enjoy WiFi and entertainment options during your journey.
