This mod offers various features for sim pregnancies, including multiple pregnancy preferences, diverse reactions for both sims, risk of ñiqui ñiqui transmission, protection options, fertility surgeries, and more. Some characteristics are optional and can be removed if desired. The majority of the features in this mod are adjustable, allowing users to customize their experience. The mod includes several modules that can be enabled or disabled, including Risk & Protection (pregnancy risk, protection, and fertility), Pregnancy Termination (abortions), WTDs (sexually transmitted diseases from ñiqui ñiqui – requires the Risk & Protection module), PaternityTesting (paternity tests), TeenPregnancy (teenage pregnancy and reactions to teenage pregnancy), PregnancyAcceptance (possibility of accepting unwanted pregnancy), CheatingModule (cheating-related interactions), and AlternativePregnancy (artificial insemination). To download the mod, visit the link provided or check out the Patreon page of the creator. The description of the mod highlights its various features and options, including desires and preferences for pregnancy, risk of ñiqui ñiqui transmission, protection options, and more. The translation is available in Spanish on the Simlish 4 website, and users can download it from there. Mod 9 enables adoption through agencies or friends/family, complete with a more realistic process. Sims can also search for their biological parents. Mod 10 tackles custody and permanent separations, including custody visits and amicable or not-so-amicable splits. The optional Mod 11 allows Sims to terminate pregnancy preferences. Mod 13 introduces miscarriage and pregnancy loss, with optional additions to the family tree and urn creation for mourning. Mod 16 brings a customizable dating app with visible profiles, relationship goals, and various filters. Mod 18 expands WooHoo options, including anywhere WooHoo, multiple partners, and parties. Future mods will include DNA testing, romantic trust, post-pregnancy recovery, social judgment, and the impact of love languages on relationships. Autonomous Drama Option - A Mod Extension This optional mod expansion will unleash autonomous storytelling for players seeking a more dramatic experience. Sims can now independently initiate actions like requesting adoption or protection changes, as well as request relationship breaks or full separations, amicable or not. The NPC spouse can also unexpectedly confess an affair, adding an extra layer of surprise. Upcoming Additions and Updates Planned expansions include additions to existing modules such as WooHoo Transmissible Diseases, Teen module, Separations module, and others.
